Pamela Huffman

Huffman's 44-year career as music educator spans all levels. From 2007 to retirement in 2023, she served as the Director of Choral Activities at SMU's Meadows School of the Arts, overseeing the M.M. Choral Conducting program & directed SMU's choral ensembles. Prior, she served as Associate Director of Choral Activities at Texas Tech University from 2001-2007. Huffman has worked in New York, NY; Austin, TX; Urbana, IL; and Atlanta, GA.

An accomplished vocalist, Huffman sang with the late Robert Shaw from 1988-1999, performing and recording with the Robert Shaw Festival Singers, the Robert Shaw Choral Institutes, the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra Chorus, and the Atlanta Symphony Chamber Chorus. In 2003, she joined the Grammy Award-winning, *Conspirare*, under direction of Craig Hella Johnson.

Huffman serves as a choral adjudicator and is a sought-after workshop clinician, particularly in the area of the choral techniques of Robert Shaw.

Huffman holds degrees in music from the U of Texas at Austin and a D.M.A. in Choral Conducting from the U of Illinois, Champaign-Urbana. She is a Past President of TCDA and is also a member of TMEA, ACDA, and Pi Kappa Lambda.

DR. Joni Jensen

Jensen is the Director of Choral Activities & Assoc Professor of Voice at Texas Woman's U. She conducts 2 TWU choirs and teaches voice & conducting.

She received her bachelor's in vocal performance & pedagogy & her master's degree in choral conducting from Brigham Young U in Provo, UT. She has a DMA in choral conducting, from the U of Arizona. Dr. Jensen studied under Dr. M. Wilberg, Dr. R. Staheli, and Dr. B. Chamberlain.

Dr. Jensen has conducted numerous honor and festival choirs and serves as a choral clinician and adjudicator throughout the US. She has conducted all-state ensembles in OK, CO, and IL. Dr. Jensen has several pieces published with Walton Music, including "El Vito," a 2014 Texas all-state piece. She is the editor of a series at Hal Leonard for advanced women's choral music and has many pieces published there as well.

Dr. Jensen serves as Musical Director & Conducting Chair for Millennial Choirs & Orchestras. Aside from her performing and teaching, she has research interests in vocal pedagogy in the choral setting, choral conducting technique, Baroque performance practice, women's chorus lit, & choral arranging.

Kay Owens

Owens is recently retired from forty-one years of teaching secondary choral music. Owens taught 10 years in Mississippi and 31 years in Texas, 26 years being at Martin HS in Arlington, TX.

Owens' choirs have performed at TMEA (2005, 2008, 2016); ACDA (2005, 2013); Carnegie Hall (2006, 2016); Bella Hall, Canada (2023); Cadogan Hall, London England (2019, 2024).

Ms. Owens is a member of TMEA, ACDA, TCDA, and TMAA. She has served on the TCDA Executive Board 2009-2001. Kay was named the 2009 Distinguished Alumnae of the College of Music for Mississippi College. In 2013, Owens was honored with the UIL Sponsor Excellence Award. Owens was the recipient of the 2020 TCDA Choral Excellence Award. Kay currently serves on the TMAA Executive Board as Vocal VP. In retirement Kay continues to serve as the organist at First Baptist Church Arlington, teaches private voice lessons, and loves to travel.

Ms. Owens now serves as the Artistic Director for the Arlington Master Chorale in Arlington, Texas.
